

## WELCOME TO BRANDENBURG!

You are currently staying at an initial reception center for refugees in Brandenburg. This facility is operated by the Central Immigration Authority (ZABH) of the State of Brandenburg, which is responsible for your housing, meals, and medical care, as well as your relocation within Brandenburg. This authority does not process your asylum application. The Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (BAMF) is responsible for that. After several months, you will be assigned to a city or a district in Brandenburg. Depending on the status of your asylum proceedings and your family situation, the timing of your relocation may be sooner or later.

There are four large independent cities and fourteen counties in Brandenburg to which you may be assigned. This flyer offers you an initial orientation to the new location. For each independent city and each county, you will find contact information for an advice center. You can contact these centers as needed after your assignment. Advice centers in your new location will support and advise you on questions regarding asylum and residency law, healthcare, education, higher education, employment, or social benefits. The counseling is free of charge, and language interpretation can be arranged. For certain needs, you will be referred to other specialist agencies in your area.

You can find helpful contacts for other advice centers, initiatives, and migrant self-organizations groups in your area in the directory on the website of the Refugee Council of Brandenburg.

The Refugee Council of Brandenburg and the VASiB network are committed to ensuring that you receive information about your rights from the very beginning of your stay in Brandenburg and that you are comprehensively advised, accompanied and supported in your concerns.
